

For the Seven Months Ended October 31, 2020 Prepared November 6, 2020, CLRamsdell, CPA, CGMA

We are seven months into the fiscal year and operating remotely due to the pandemic.

Operating income totals 432k, expenses total 491k, and the resulting deficit is 59k, which is 6k better than budget and 70k better than last year.

FY21 Revenue Highlights:

Operating income is 113k behind budget and 41k behind last year.

Gifts from <u>Individuals</u> include 134k for the Climate Fund, 2k for the Emeritus Fund, and 140k for operations, which is 23k behind budget and 11k behind last year.

<u>Foundation</u> gifts at 250k include 128k for the Climate Fund, 25k for future use, and 97k for operations this year, which is 33k behind budget and 3k ahead of last year.

Government revenue is 44k, which is 45k behind budget and 59k behind last year. Last year we hosted the pumpout boat launch event and received pumpout reimbursement income; this year, with pumpout operations suspended, this line item will be under budget for the year and will be offset with corresponding lower operating costs.

Nonprofit revenue at 10k is 5k ahead of budget and on par with last year.

Releases of fund are 16k behind budget as we will not be releasing funds that had been budgeted for the Ocean Gateway 30th public campaign launch event; we have corresponding cost savings and these funds will remain unspent and will be available for future use in our climate work.

FY21 Expenditure Highlights:

Operating expenses total 491k, which is 119k under budget.

- Compensation expenses are lower by 45k, as we have not yet hired a staff writer due to remote working and we are paying our pumpout captain at half salary to honor our verbal seasonal contract.
- Program expenses are lower because we are doing such things as having meetings online (lower travel reimbursements) and minimizing boat trips, and some of the differences are due to timing, meaning certain budgeted expenses have not yet been incurred but will be incurred eventually.
- Management and administrative expenses are underbudget, in large part due to an allowance for an increase in rent that is in the budget, but we have not yet moved. Staff members have been receiving a nominal monthly reimbursement to offset the costs of working from home (internet, electricity).
- Fundraising expenses are under budget because we are not hosting in person events; we shifted to online events.

Operating expenses year-to-date are 112k less than last year. Differences from last year:

- compensation 43k: last year we had one more person on staff and more pumpout related compensation
- program expenses 81k: last year we used dedicated funds to hire the facilitator for MOCA (10k more); upgraded continuous monitoring station equipment (45k); launched the pumpout boat, hosted the launch event, and operated the vessel (14k more); acquired canvas cover for the boat (4k); spent more on travel and other activities that this year's shutdown has curtailed (5k)
- fundraising expenses are lower last year: this year we are incurring campaign expenses as we conduct the public phase, and last year to date we had spent 10k for special event activities.

An analysis of this year's budgeted revenue and expenses that are not going to materialize because of the shutdown has yielded an almost neutral effect in the aggregate, 5k to 10k in our favor.

- No Ocean Gateway 30th anniversary/campaign public phase launch event: revenue decrease of 7.5k for tickets plus 42k in a release of campaign funds with offset cost savings of 42k. Net effect: -7.5k
- Suspension of pumpout operations: revenue decrease of 47k DEP reimbursements plus 13k pumpout fees, offset by 13k in lower program costs. Net effect: -47k
- Film Festival cancelled: revenue decrease of 28k from sponsorships and ticket sales, offset by expense savings of 9k. Net effect: -19k
- House party and donor thank you events canceled (donor event will be online): cost savings of 14k
- Contingency expense unused: cost savings 12k
- Delay in hiring Staff Writer: cost savings 50k

We do not know what the effect may be by year's end on charitable giving for operations.

Capital Activity:

Cash flow is in good shape. We received 130k in SBA Payroll Protection Funds in April; this is currently classified as a loan, and it is our hope that we will qualify for forgiveness and the loan will eventually be reclassified as a special government grant. We will begin the process of applying for forgiveness in late November.

At the end of October, **operating** cash **not including the 130k**, totaled 252k, and that with Accounts Receivable of 38k (not including Climate Fund pledges of 296k) together total 290k, as compared with 178k last year at this time (128k in operating cash and 50k in A/R, not including 213k in Climate Fund pledges).

Re: Third Quarter Fund Statements

Third-quarter markets gained ground despite some downward pull. At the end of the third quarter, MaineCF's Primary Pool had rebounded in value to its pre-pandemic level. For the three-month period ended September 30, the Primary Pool rose approximately 5% compared to our benchmark,* which was up 6%. For the first three quarters of 2020, the Primary Pool is up about 3.5% while our benchmark gained 1%.

The investment results and financial activity of the MaineCF fund you established or advise are enclosed. A line-by-line legend for the accompanying statement can be found on the reverse of this memo. This information is also posted at <u>www.mainecf.org</u>, on the Fundholders page (under the Support/Start a Fund tab on the home page).

Since March, MaineCF has awarded more than 300 grants totaling nearly \$3 million from the COVID-19 Emergency Response Fund. These funds came from new gifts, donor-advised fund transfers, and a board discretionary fund. Our emergency grantmaking has focused on nonprofit services to people most vulnerable to pandemic impacts, including those experiencing poverty, homelessness, hunger, child care needs, mental health disorders, violence, and/or substance use disorders. For information about these grants, go to www.mainecf.org.

We hope to award more COVID-related grants this fall to nonprofits, many of which report dramatic decreases in revenue. Additional contributions to the COVID-19 Emergency Response Fund are welcomed. Also, in response to the pandemic, many of MaineCF's other grant programs have added an option for general support grants, recognizing that most nonprofits were unable to hold regular fundraising events and are struggling to maintain programs and services.

Our fall Maine Ties newsletter will be mailed soon. Features include an interview with philanthropist Maddy Corson on the occasion of the 20th anniversary of MaineCF's Guy P. Gannett Scholarship Fund for Maine students pursuing journalism. Additionally, we profile Mary Kate Reny of Damariscotta and Ann Marie Bartoo of Phippsburg, co-chairs of our Southern Midcoast Committee. We also highlight a Skowhegan History House cultural project, supported by MaineCF's Expansion Arts Fund, in which artisan and former Penobscot Tribal Chief Barry Dana engaged high school students in building a wigwam.

MaineCF's Ellsworth office addition, now complete, expands the train station that has housed the community foundation since 1998. Funds for the expansion were generously donated through a bequest. Most staff members will continue to work remotely through the end of this year but can be reached by phone or email.

Thank you for your support to improve the quality of life for all Maine people in these challenging times.
